Minutes

Oct 20, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes from the September Meeting were reviewed, Diane made motion to approve and Lissa seconded, MC.

Treasurer's Report: Bob read Sept Treasurer report, Diane made motion to approve, Wendy seconded, MC.

Athletic Director's Corner: Georgia reported that Girls Volleyball won in first round of Regionals and will play in Dodgeland on Friday Oct. 22, if they win then will play again on Sat. Varsity Football plays Lakeside Lutheran Thursday, Oct 21 – the outcome of this game will determine where we play for first round of playoffs on Tuesday, Oct. 26. A win would mean Poynette would host the game. The Soccer Season has come to a close. Upcoming sports beginning in November – Girls Basketball Nov 17, Boys Basketball Nov 15, Wrestling Nov 15, and Hockey Nov 8. Georgie reported they had concerns regarding Homecoming activities and requested suggestions for traditional evening activities be emailed to her for next year. The choir teacher is going to work with choir students with wording on the school song so that they may lead students in singing the song at games. Max Grinde has accepted the position as the new JV Boys Basketball coach and there is an offer on the table for a Freshman Girls coach.

Old Business

Homecoming Tailgate – signup: Profits from the tailgate were around \$900 – will have exact amount at next meeting.

Gym Wall Mats: The mats have been ordered and the club is providing \$4,500 towards the purchase of the mats. We will be able to approach Pioneer for additional grant money to assist in these costs once the mats are purchased. Georgia asked that Bob Tomlinson facilitate the transfer and placement of the mats in the Varsity gym to the Auxiliary gym. Bob O suggested a Booster Club member give approval of the new mats upon arrival at the school to ensure they meet expectations.

Future of PABC: Bob received a letter from the school regarding the future of the organization. The Club Charter the school currently has is outdated and Bob will provide Georgia with current charter. The vote will be delayed until a later date.


New Business


Basketball Uniform Request (J.Weiss): A request has been made from the new Boys Basketball Coach for assistance in purchasing new “away” game uniforms. Discussion: Bob Tomlinson noted the Varsity Club donated funds towards the current uniforms which are between 4-5 years old. It has been the policy of the Booster Club not to aide in the purchase of the team uniforms however, we would be happy to assist in a fundraising event to help the Basketball Team purchase the requested uniforms. Bob Tomlinson made a motion that the Booster Club not get involved in the purchase of the uniforms for teams. Nan seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Zeigler Fund Raiser: Doris Zeigler and Kathy Jochman approached the club regarding doing a Mary Kay Fundraiser at future home basketball games. The purpose of the fundraiser is to sell Mary Kay products at upcoming home basketball games, sales would be conducted during three home games for both boys and girls basketball. Doris and Kathy would take orders during the game and all orders would be processed and delivered by them. Following the final

event, a check comprising of 25% of sales would be presented to the Booster Club. Bob Tomlinson made a motion that we go through with the fundraiser provided we have approval from administration for the Mary Kay Fundraiser. Lissa seconded and motion carried. Doris and Kathy will work with Georgia to coordinate dates for the event.

Buses for Football Playoff Games: Discussion ensued regarding the possibility of the Booster Club paying for buses to take students/fans to the football playoff games.

 Bob Tomlinson made a motion that authorizes Bob O to order buses comparable to what is needed to take students to a playoff game. Lissa seconded – MC.

 T-Shirts for playoff games was also discussed. Buck made a motion for Laurie J, Diane and Lissa investigate the purchase of t-shirts if the Pumas reach Level 3 playoff game and have the authority to purchase up to \$1,500 worth of shirts to be sold at \$10 per shirt. Davey seconded, MC.

Raffle Licenses: State Licenses Raffle tickets have arrived. Buck will begin putting together various raffle possibilities with cash and donated prizes for next meeting.

Other New Business: Buck brought up the issue of building restrooms near the football field. Issue of whether or not the School District will allow restrooms to be constructed in the area needs to be addressed. Bob O appointed Buck to investigate cost of building, factors needing to be addressed first are: Will Administration approve building restrooms for public use at games, how many stalls would be included in the building etc.

Davey made motion to adjourn and Lissa seconded, motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
